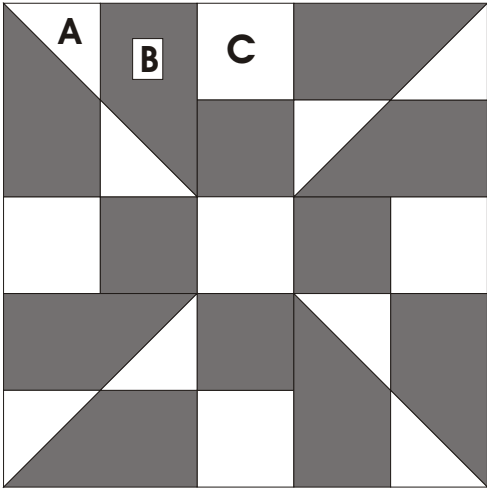
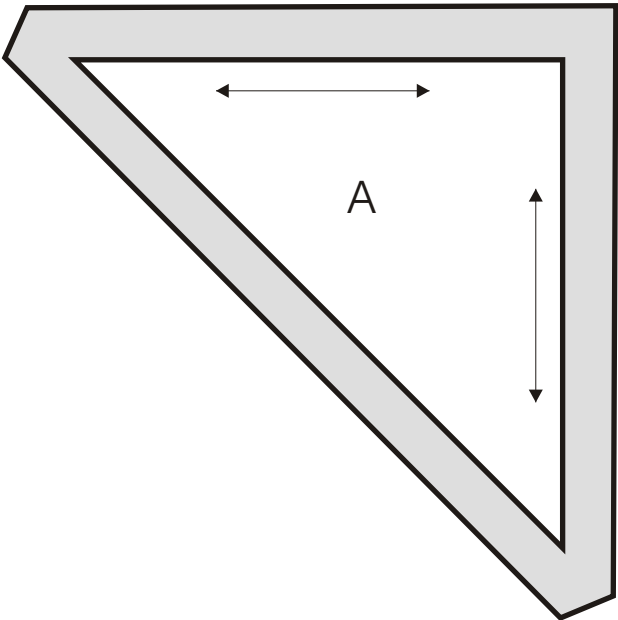

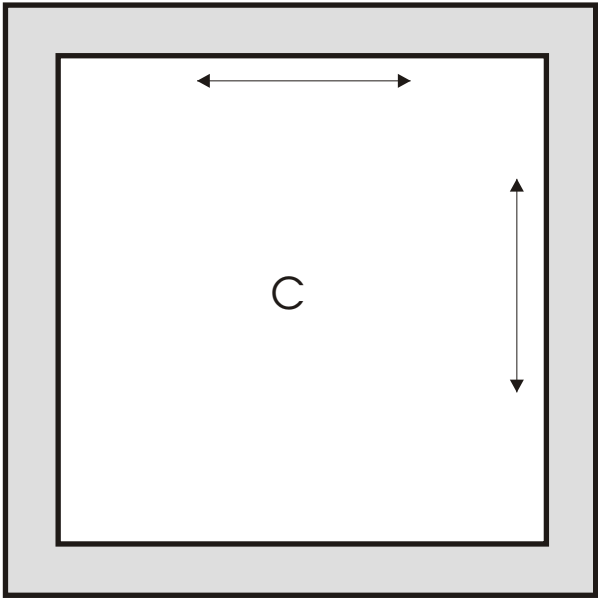
Note: Arrows indicate where the straight grain of fabric should be when placing templates. If there aren't any arrows use the written notes for layout instructions.



12 Inch Block



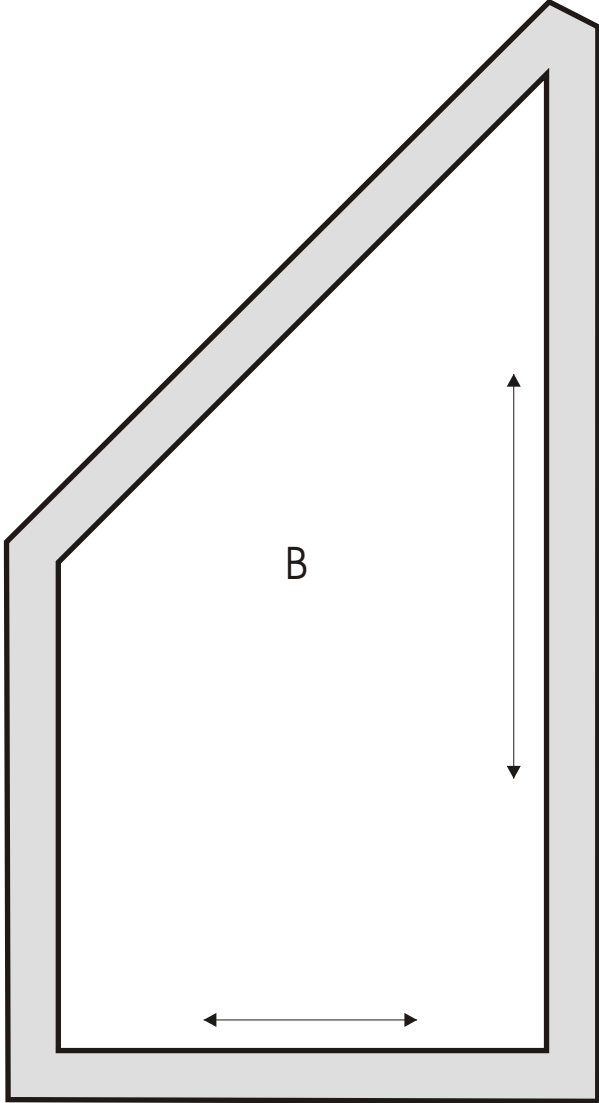
Cut 8 Light

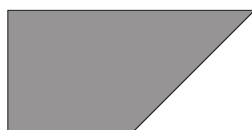
## Assembly Instructions

Make your templates, you can either make them with the 1/4 seam allowance included or without. I prefer without. Or you can make 2 sets of templates one with the seam allowance and one without.

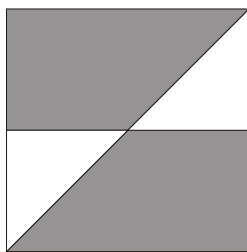
Mark and cut the number of pieces of each unit as noted on each template. Watch your grain lines. Be very careful that you do **NOT** flip the B template while marking, all 8 of the B pieces should be the same.

8 of - A - in a Light fabric  
8 of - B - in a Dark fabric  
5 of - C - in a Light fabric  
4 of - C - in a Dark fabric

1. Take the 8 - A - light triangles and the 8 - B - Dark shapes and sew together to form a rectangle. Be careful when sewing the seam to not stretch it, as you are sewing two bias edges together. The completed units should look like this:



2. Next assemble the corner units of the block by taking 2 of the - A - B - rectangles and sewing them together so that the triangles face opposite directions as shown below:

Assembly Instructions Continue:

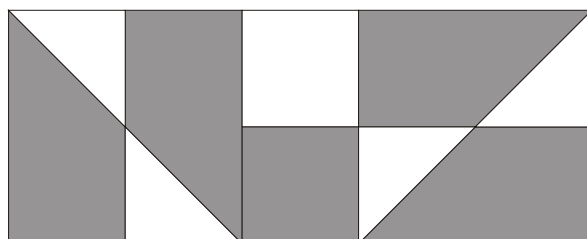
- Using one light - C - square and one Dark - C - square sew them together to make a rectangle that looks like the one shown. Sew 2 of these rectangles.



- Take the 5 remaining - C - squares and sew together as a strip alternating light and dark squares. Start and end with a light square. This is the center strip of the block and should look like the image below:



- Using 2 of the square - A - B - units and 1 of the - C - rectangles assemble the top row, use the image below to get the right orientation of the - A - B - units to each other, they are rotated 90 degrees, so please look before you sew. The light square of the - C - rectangle should be on the outer edge of the block when it is completed. Sew 2 of these sections.

Assembly Instructions Continue:

6. Assemble the block using the 2 rows assembled in section 5 and the center strip. Again watch the orientation of the triangles, the bottom row is a mirror image of the top row.
