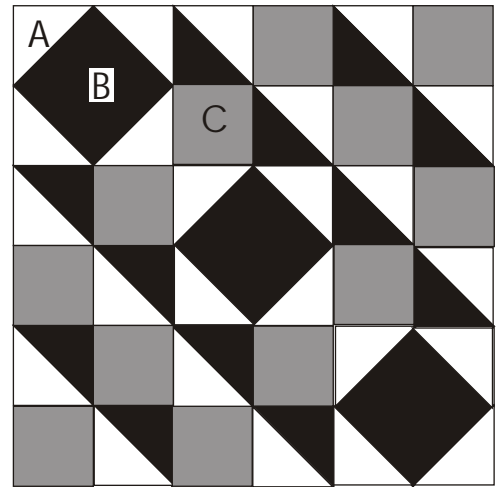
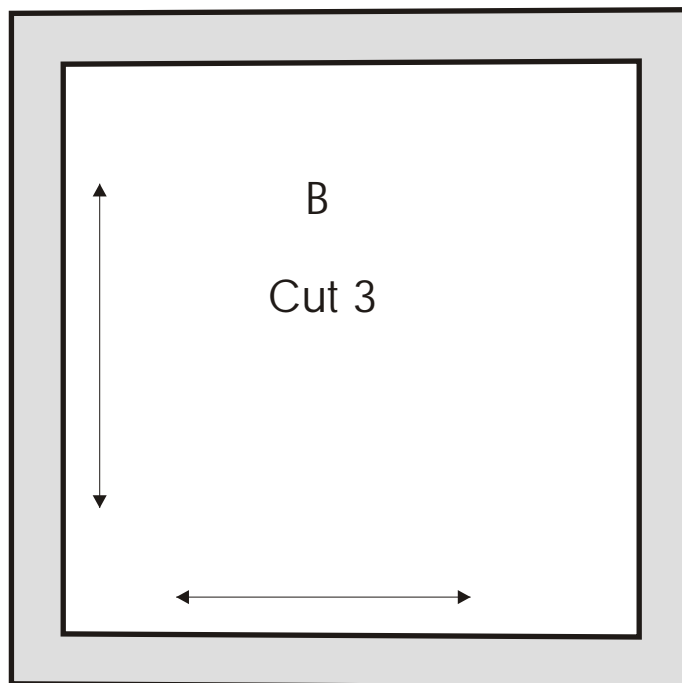
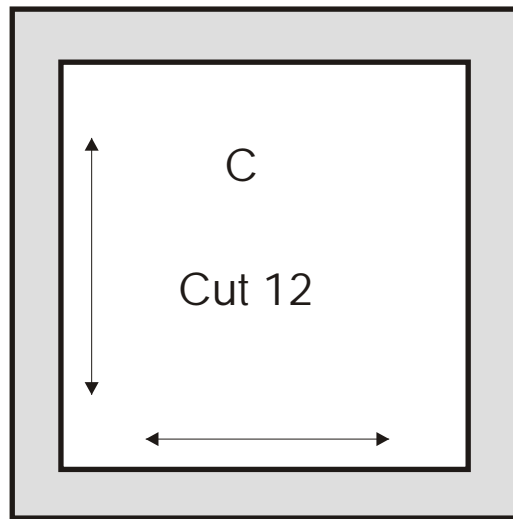


Flying Shuttles

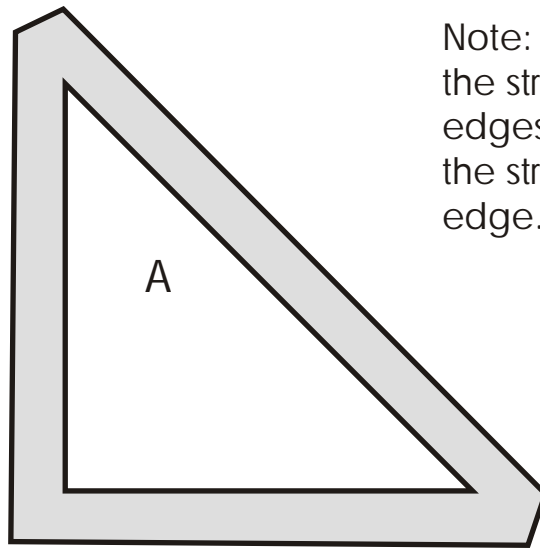
Note: Arrows indicate where the straight grain of fabric should be when placing templates. If there aren't any arrows use the written notes for layout instructions.



12 Inch Block

Note: Cut the 24 light A's with the straight of grain on the short edges, cut the 12 Dark A's with the straight of grain on the long edge.

Cut 36 Total
Cut 12 Dark
Cut 24 Light

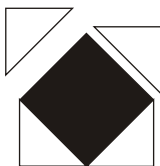
Assembly Instructions

Make your templates, you can either make them with the 1/4 seam allowance included or without. I prefer without. Or you can make 2 sets of templates one with the seam allowance and one without.

Mark and cut the number of pieces of each unit as noted on each template. Watch your grain lines.

24 of - A - in a light fabric
12 of - A - in a Dark fabric
3 of - B - in a Dark fabric
12 of - C - in a Medium fabric

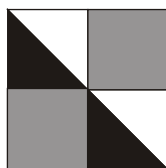
1. Assemble the 3 -B- & -A- units. For each -B- piece attach one light -A- to each side (4 light -A- for each -B-) so that you square the square. Assemble 3 of these subunits. This will use 12 of the -A- light units.



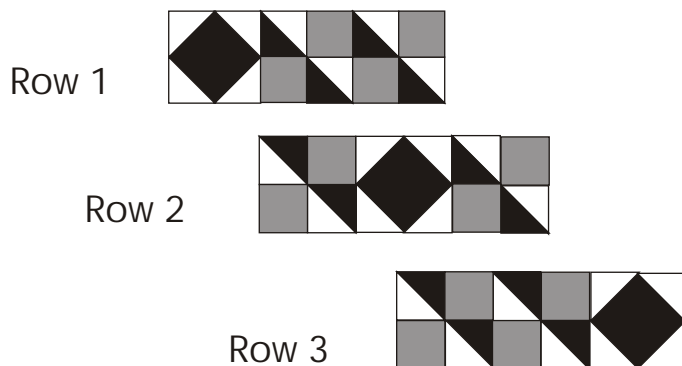
2. Using the remaining 12 light -A-'s with the 12 dark -A-'s sewing them together in pairs along the long edge to make squares. You will end up with 12 squares that look like this:



- Next you will assemble the -C-A-A- square sub units. Take 2 of the -C-Medium squares and 2 of the -A-A- squares and sew them together to make a square unit that looks like the square below. Make sure you keep the Dark triangles pointed in the same direction.



- Next assemble the three rows. Each row uses one -A-B- square and 2 -A-A-C- squares. Row one starts with the -A-B- square followed by two -A-A-C- units. The middle row has the -A-B- unit in the middle, with an -A-A-C- unit on each side. Watch the direction of the dark -A- triangle. On one side, the left on my block, they point up, and on the other side they point down. Sew the 3rd row as a reverse of the first row 2 -A-A-C- squares and one -A-B- squares. Again watch the direction of the dark triangles. I have them pointing up. See drawing of rows below:



- Assemble the rows to complete the block.
