Sister Kimberley Mccollum, a city letter carrier in East Chicago, Indiana is in need of help after a fire devastated her home on February 11, 2008 and caused the untimely death of her youngest son Trevone. Kimberley's youngest daughter, Tramyra, was burned on her feet and is still in the burn care unit in the hospital and it will take weeks before she can walk again. Kimberley broke her ankle in two places and is unable to return to work at this time.

They have no home to go to and are staying temporarily with relatives in Joliet, Illinois.
